## Calvary Chapel Youth Code of Conduct

When at a youth event with Calvary Chapel Antelope Valley, whether at Church or on a youth activity, the following expectations and behaviors must be adhered to and are considered the youth travel Code of Conduct. This Code of Conduct must read, understood and signed by each youth and a parent. Parents: If your youth(s) is/are not abiding by the Code of Conduct during a youth event, you will need to travel to the event to pick them up.

- We travel as a group and we stay together as a group.
- All cars must travel together. If one needs to stop then all stop with it.
- All youth must travel to and from each event in the same vehicle and must stay with their group leader.
- All youth will sit together and stay together as a group at events.
- Youth that need to use the restroom during an event must take someone with them of the same gender.
- Physical outward touching (kissing, embracing, & others demonstration of affection between girls/boys are not permitted during the event.
- No headphones are to be used during teachings and group activities.
- Cell phones are allowed but are to be used for emergencies and taking pictures/videos.
- Youth must obey directions given by leaders.
- Youth who are unruly, disrespectful, and/or do not follow youth leader instructions will have their parents contacted for removal from the event.
